1. Call to Order

- a. G. Slay called the meeting to order.
- **2. Previous Meeting Minutes**: D. Bellon motioned to approve the previous meeting minutes. J. Boldt seconded the motion. All in favor—motion passes.
- **3.** Landscaping RFP Responses: G. Slay gave an overview of Landscaping RFP submissions, highlighting costs and services provided. He wanted to know if there could be something put in the boxes/pots besides flowers. D. Bellon said he would research some type of grass for the flower boxes or artists to put some type of sculpture in them. D. Bellon motioned to hold off on picking a proposal. A.
